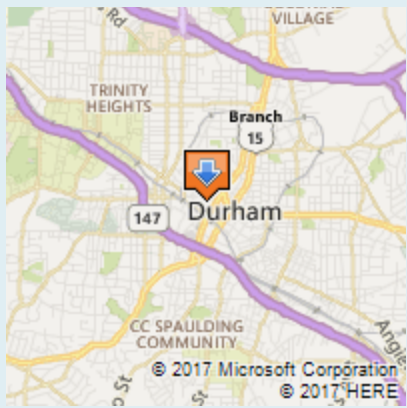
Dear Fellow Professional :

Please consider our special invitation to attend this special field trip to One City Center. The tour will be given by Tom Daumeyer, Armada Hoffer Construction, and Chris Bostic, PE, Kimley-Horn.

Required safety gear is hard hats, work boots (don't have to be steeled toe), 3" minimum on sleeves, no ripped or torn clothing, safety glasses & high visibility vest (or shirt).

Attendance limited to first 30 registrants.

Built on the site of the former Woolworth's, One City Center is a 27-story, \$88M project in the heart of Downtown Durham. With

four of its stories below ground, the tower will have two floors of parking, four floors of retail and offices and 21 floors of residences, with a pool on the top floor. Duke University has already committed to leasing 55,000 SF of office space.

Kimley-Horn is providing civil engineering services for the City Center project, including entitlement support, traffic management/constructing staging plans, erosion control design and coordination, construction drawings, LEED certification services, and construction phase services.

The City Center site is located on the ridge between the Neuse and Cape Fear river basins in the heart of Downtown Durham and was subject to both Falls Lake and Jordan Lake stormwater rules. Kimley-Horn worked with the City of Durham stormwater staff as well as researchers at NC State to design and model the first tree-box filter stormwater control measure in Downtown Durham.

Armada Hoffler Properties is both a minority joint-venture partner in the project, as well as the project's construction manager through its Armada Hoffler Construction arm of the business. Armada Hoffler is based in Virginia Beach, VA. The company has built millions of square feet worth billions of dollars and have been ranked among the "Top 400 General Contractors" nationwide by Engineering News Record.
