What we'll be seeing:

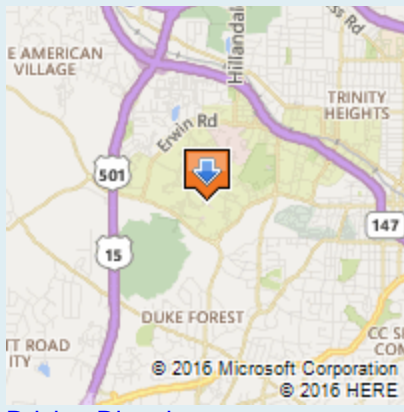
#### **Wallace Wade Tower**

This 95,000-sf new football building includes suites, dining facilities, press box and stadium operations. The field was lowered 5 feet and the track removed in order to bring seating closer to the field.

#### **Scott Family Pavilion**

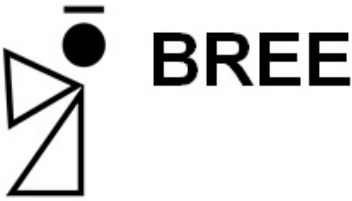

A 17,300-sf addition to the front of Cameron Indoor Stadium consists of a new south entry lobby and a new hospitality suite. Also included is Blue Devil Plaza, a new outdoor plaza which will enhance the game day experience for both basketball and football events.

He has worked in California, New York, Connecticut, and Massachusetts. John holds a Bachelors of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute, a Masters Degree in Business Administration from Columbia University and is a Professional Engineer.
