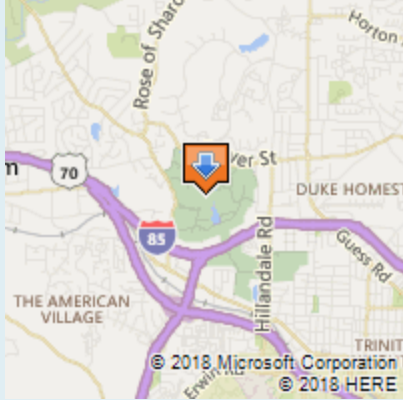

NCDOT/DOA requirements for commercial UAS operation in North Carolina. We will look at Board Rules that govern this type of work and explain who can legally provide these services. We will conclude by examining the foundation of UAS to give the licensee an understanding of what is required to competently practice in this area while protecting the health, safety and welfare of the public.

Mike has been an active member of the North Carolina Society of Surveyors (NCSS) since 1991, serving as the chairman of the Formal Education Committee from 1993-2000, President of NCSS in 2003 and the North Carolina Delegate to the Board of Governors for the National Society of Professional Surveyors from 2008-2013. On November 06, 2012, Mike was appointed by Governor Beverly Perdue to serve on the Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors (NCBEES). Since being on the Board Mike has served two years as the Chairman of the Surveying Committee and in 2017 served as the Board Chairman. As an active member of NCBEES, Mike was appointed by the President of the National Council of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors (NCEES) to serve on the Future of Surveying Task Force and as a consultant to the Education Committee.
