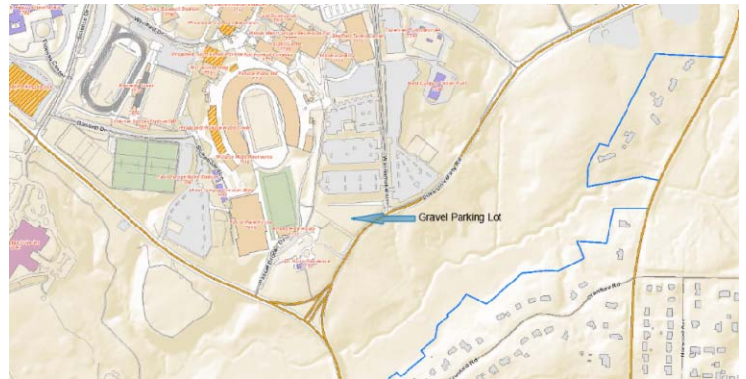

new playing field and seating sections where the old running track was removed; a new scoreboard, new ADA seating sections, and a new 95,000-sq. ft. 5-story press/luxury box tower. The Cameron Indoor Expansion project is a 2-story 14,000-sq. ft. addition on the south entrance of the building. The first floor will increase the size of the lobby, and the second floor will be a club level. The Scott Family Pavilion will be a 50,000- sq. ft. addition to the existing Murray Building. This facility will have a Duke/Nike retail space, ticket office, Athletic Dept. administration offices, and Olympic Sports training facilities.

Park in the gravel parking lot near the intersection of Wannamaker Drive and Duke University Road, as shown in the map below. Meet at the Beck Group's site office at 5:30 PM.
