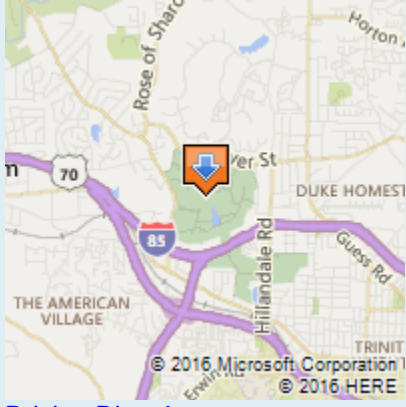

The presentation will address how Duke wanted to use their new softball field as a sand filter for storm water treatment, and how the field design was altered to meet the sand filter standards and requirements established by the NC Department of Environmental Quality and City of Durham Public Works Department.
