

In 2004, Michael Slack joined the National Capital Region Cyber Protection Center, a part of the Army Reserve Cyber Operations Group, to serve as a subject matter expert for information security and computer network defense. Over the past eleven years he has served in many capacities in the defense of our nation's information infrastructure. Currently in charge of Cyber Protection Team 183, Lieutenant Colonel Slack has previously served on active duty as a cyber operations planner for the Joint Functional Component Command - Network Warfare, and as the director of operations for all US Army cyber security throughout Southwest Asia.

Michael will speak about general trends in information security, as well as certain threats that exist in the environment, today. He will touch on matters that apply to our home lives, and will also talk of matters that affect our civil infrastructure in relation



to cyber defense.

Over the past 27 years, Michael has served the Army throughout the United States, Germany, Kuwait, Iraq, Saudi Arabia, and Afghanistan. Michael's awards include the Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal, and Army Commendation Medal. In his civilian life, Michael is the Enterprise Storage Manager for the Duke Clinical Research Institute's Information Technology Department, where he has worked since 2000. Michael is a 1993 graduate of the University of Minnesota with a degree in Political Science, and earned a Master of Science in Information Assurance from Norwich University in 2007. weather.
