The primary purpose of the Duke Water Reclamation Pond is to provide a non-potable water source to centralized Chiller Plant #2 within the Duke main campus. Duke is the City of Durham's largest water customer by volume. In October 2007, the NC Drought Management Advisory Council listed Durham County in the highest category of D4-Exceptional Drought. This prompted Duke to form a drought response team and implement a number of conservation measures, including the Water Reclamation Pond..
