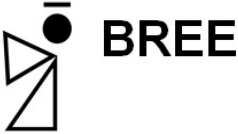

Chuck Flink, FASLA, is an award winning author, environmental planner and landscape architect. Chuck authored *Greenways A Guide to Planning, Design and Development* and *Trails for the Twenty First Century*. He is best known for his work in planning and designing greenways, multi use trails and open space systems. He has completed work in 36 states for more than 235 communities. Chuck has also consulted in Argentina, Brazil, Canada, the Czech Republic, China, Hungary, Japan and Venezuela.

Chuck is the Chairman of the Board of Visitors at NC State University, and also serves on the NC State College of Design Leaders Council. Chuck is a 1982 graduate of NC State and has operated his company, Greenways Incorporated, for 28 years.

For the past three years, Chuck has served as the project director for the 38-mile Northwest Arkansas Razorback Regional Greenway. This project will link together six communities of the region and is funded in part by a federal transportation TIGER 2 grant of \$15 million. The matching grant funding is provided by the Walton Family Foundation. The Razorback Greenway is an investment in the future of NW Arkansas, serving to create more than 350 permanent jobs, and boosting tourism revenues in the region. The greenway is regarded as one of the most important economic cornerstone projects in NW Arkansas.

Chuck has managed the efforts of an 11-member consultant team, comprised of engineering, real estate and landscape architecture firms. During the past three years, Chuck has been responsible for all facets of project management, including all facets of design, engineering, real estate acquisition, bidding and construction for the project. Chuck has also led efforts to broaden the funding partnership, and to market and promote the greenway project.
