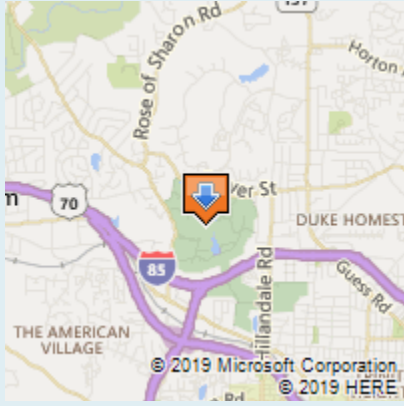

***How I Learned to Stop  
Worrying and Love  
Engineering Failures***

North Carolina is the second largest producer of hogs in the country and the third in terms of biomethane potential. The presentation will describe how biogas, renewable natural gas, climate neutrality and North Carolina's efforts to move the swine industry to improved waste management systems intersect. It will also provide an opportunity to consider ways biogas can be used to propel further waste management.

Tatjana (Tanja) Vujic is the Director of Biogas Strategy for Duke University, where she's working to acquire a supply of biogas to provide a renewable fuel source to power the University's steam generating plants. For more than a decade, Tanja has been involved in various aspects of biogas development and animal waste management efforts, working as a project developer, a policy advocate and a researcher evaluating potential solutions. In all of these roles, Tanja has focused on creating policies and economic incentives that encourage market-based solutions to this waste management challenge. Tanja also works on evaluating biogas potential from other sectors, such as waste water treatment plants, crop residues and other animal production.
