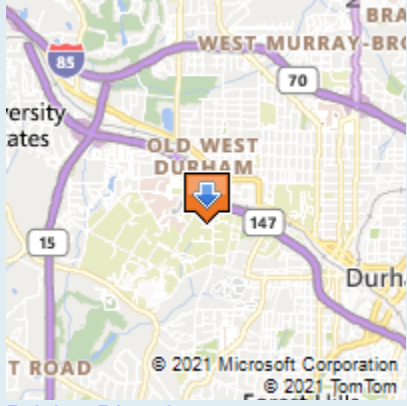

Areas we will tour include, the chiller bay, mechanical and chemical handling rooms, electrical rooms, cooling tower system, and thermal storage system.
