In his civilian role, Michael works at the Norwich University Applied Research Institute where he assists the Energy and Transportation critical infrastructure sectors to test and improve organizational resiliency. Michael also serves with the Town of Morrisville's Smart City Steering Committee. He holds a BA in Political Science from the University of Minnesota, a Master of Science in Information Assurance from Norwich University, and a Masters in Strategic Studies from the US Army War College.

Michael has decades of experience in information technology operations, architecture, and security in support of healthcare and research. An Information Network Engineer for the Army, he has extensive experience across the realm of cyber in operational and leadership positions, on active duty and reserve status. Michael holds the Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP) certification and five Global Information

Assurance Certification (GIAC) certifications, amongst others.

Michael has spoken with the Durham Engineers Club twice before. The first time, he walked us through restoring community infrastructure and services in the disaster of an active warzone. He returned to describe one of the most destructive cyber-attacks ever acknowledged. Now, he'll have a conversation about planning for the worst. 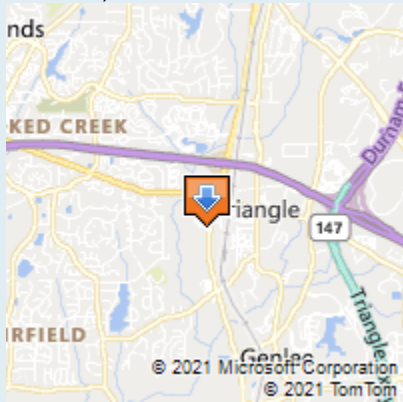
